ORDER PERMITTING FILMING IN MARITAL RESIDENCE

PORSHADYANNE WILLIAMS, Petitioner, in the above-styled case (hereinafter “Wife”), having filed her *Request for Emergency Order Permitting Filming in Marital Residence* on May 20, 2024, Respondent, Simon Iyore Guobadia, having filed his *Response in Opposition to Petitioner’s Request for Emergency Order Permitting Filming in Marital Residence* on June 21, 2024 and *Respondent’s Objection to Petitioner’s Proposed Order on Filming in Martial Residence and Objection to Court’s Consideration of Facts not in Evidence* on October 24, 2024, and the Court having considered the pleadings, and applicable Georgia law, it is hereby ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that Wife’s temporary sole, and exclusive possession, use, and occupancy of the Marital Residence, includes Wife’s unrestricted right to film and produce television, film or social media or other audiovisual content in and around the Marital Residence. If necessary, Husband shall execute any and all documents necessary to facilitate Wife’s ability to film and Husband’s release to film, returning any documents received within forty-eight (48) hours. All other issues are reserved for further determination.
